Section 2 – Composition/Information on Ingredients

No hazardous ingredients. All ingredients in this product are on the TSCA list. This product does not contain an amount of any chemical required to be reported under SARA 313.

Section 3 - Health Identification

No inhalation hazard expected under normal conditions of use. Prolonged inhalation of mist may cause irritation of the respiratory tracts, difficulty breathing, lightheadedness, drowsiness, and headache. Eye contact may cause slight irritation in the form of discomfort, excess blinking and tear production, and redness. Prolonged or repeated skin contact may cause slight irritation and redness.
